Experience and Epistemology as a Pathway to Empowerment

RESEARCH STUDY CURRENTLY RECRUITING

Do you have professional, volunteer, internship or informal experience
measuring power or empowerment?

We are currently seeking participants for a mixed methods study exploring experiences of measuring empowerment. All participants will be asked to complete a brief online survey, and will then have the option to participate in (a) a pair of 45 mn online interviews (b) a pair of 90 mn online interviews (c) a 60 mn online focus group - or all three!

Enrolled participants may withdraw from the study at any time

Participating in both a first and second interview provides participants the opportunity to engage with the research team's interpretation of their first interview, and to offer their own insight into their first interview.

Focus group participants will have the opportunity to reflect together on all (anonymized) information collected to date, as well as on their experience with the process overall.

In these ways, the study seeks to offer participants an opportunity to share in the power of knowledge creation, as well as an opportunity to reflect on the process.
